Well done to those who attended Scout Camp. It can be very daunting at first if you have little experience of camping. Scouts pitch their own tents, arrange their own campsite, plan their own menu and programme, get their own shopping, do their own budgeting, do their own cooking, book their own activities and generally learn how to live and work as a patrol. Leaders of course supervise and help but the aim is to get the Scouts to realise just how much they can achieve their selves. Of course this does mean that hard work is required on occasion. A lazy Scout can let their entire patrol down and cause a great deal of trouble to the programme and activities.

We are looking at making the Summer camp in July a training and reward camp. One idea we have briefly discussed is to make the Saturday to Wednesday a training camp where the Scouts gain points by handing in tokens with tips on camping (e. g. always put the water on when you have finished cooking for washing up water). Those who gain enough tips and tokens will be rewarded with days out, trips, activities and events throughout Thursday to Sunday. Scouts, if you are up for this idea please le the leaders know.
